

# **LOUISIANA STATE USBC ASSOCIATION STAR OF TOMORROW**

1. The Louisiana State USBC Association shall annually select one male and one female youth bowler, which displays exceptional commitment to the future success of bowling in Louisiana. They shall be recognized as Louisiana Stars of Tomorrow.
2. To be eligible for recognition as Star of Tomorrow, nominees must:
  - a. Be a Junior or Senior in a high school located in Louisiana with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (unweighted).
  - b. Be an active USBC Youth Member in good standing with participation in the association for at least the previous two years.
  - c. Be of good repute among his or her peers – demonstrate and promote exemplary sportsmanship.
  - d. Contribute in a significant way to the sport of bowling through certified league and tournament participation within the jurisdiction of the LA State USBC Association.
  - e. Have demonstrated superior performance in the sport of bowling at the state and national level.
3. Nominations:
  - a. Any member of the Louisiana State USBC Association may submit nominations, along with the nominee's qualifications and achievement, to the president or association manager for consideration as Star of Tomorrow.
  - b. The Youth Committee also may present names of candidates for consideration.
  - c. Nominations with supporting documents shall be submitted prior to December 1<sup>st</sup> each year.
  - d. Youth members are only eligible to receive this award once.
4. Method of Selection:
  - a. The Youth Committee shall review all nominations and recommend one male and one female recipient for board approval.

5. An induction ceremony for those selected as Stars of Tomorrow will be conducted as part of the Louisiana State USBC Association Annual meeting.
  - a. The Star of Tomorrow selectees will be presented with a plaque or symbolic award as recognition.
  - b. A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to each recipient. The scholarship will be managed and made accessible through the SMART program (Scholarship Management and Account Reporting for Tenpins). The policies of SMART govern the use of each scholarship.
