LA State USBC – Senior Championship Tournament Rules

1. Entrants must be 50 years or older to enter. Must be a resident of the State of Louisiana and hold a current membership card in a local Louisiana association, USBC and the Louisiana State USBC prior to the start of the tournament.
2. Entering Averages: Entrants will use their highest 2025-26 USBC Winter yearbook average of 21 games or more, unless their current average of 21 games or more is 10 pins higher as of October 1, 2026 with verification from league secretary or association manager. You must bring your league standing sheet to verify current average. If none of the above, the entrant will bowl scratch (220). Summer averages and travel league averages **will not** be accepted.
3. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify their average accurately in a classified or handicap tournament. Failure to use the proper average will disqualify the scores if a submitted average is lower than the actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Tournament prize winnings of \$300 in a tournament event, \$500 in a tournament, or \$1,000 in the previous 12 months must also be disclosed for possible re-rate. Correction of average can be made up to the completion of the first game of the first series.
4. Bowlers will bowl six (6) games, consisting of two 3-game sets. You may bowl all six games on the same squad or you may split the three game sets between two squads. Indicate on the front of the entry form which you would like to do.
5. Prize fees will be returned 100% to the participants. Prize ratio will be 1:8.
6. You may only enter this tournament **once**.
7. USBC Rules 319c, 319d and 319e will be in effect. Re-rating by 319e is the bowler's responsibility. Tournament management reserves the right to Re-rate or Reject any entry prior to bowling. 10 Pin rule is in effect. If your current average is 10 pins higher than your book average, then you must use the current average. This average is as of October 1, 2026.
8. Tournament winners shall be the first place winner in each division. In the event of a tie for the tournament winners, Co-champions will be declared and the money will be split between the tied bowlers. This does not apply to the USBC Senior Qualifying. Qualifiers for the USBC Senior Championships shall be determined as stated in Rule 9 below.
9. **QUALIFIERS FOR USBC SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: AGE / ELIGIBILITY**
 - Age classification for the USBC Senior Championships will be based on your age as of July 1, 2027.
 - Bowlers will not be permitted to bowl down in an age classification regardless of how they qualified in their state qualifier.
 - Competitors must have bowled a minimum of six games at their state/provincial senior tournament.
 - Competitors must be the handicap all-events winner in their respective age classification and division (Open or Women's). If a bowler moves up due to an age change as of July 1, 2027, the standings will be re-ranked and the highest handicap all events in that division will be the qualifier to nationals.
 - In the event of a tie in a division, for purposes of determining who will be eligible for the USBC Senior Championships, the bowler with the highest game, with handicap, will advance. If a tie still exists, the second-highest game, with handicap, will be used, etc."
 - The **2027 Senior Championships** will be held at Stardust Bowl, Addison, Illinois - **August 3-6, 2027**.
 - (All times local - schedule subject to change) If the winner is unable to attend, then the runner-up in that division may take their place. If the runner-up cannot go, then the next bowler in in order of finish can go – up to the 3rd place position. The \$180.00 entry fee for the National Seniors Tournament **WILL NOT** be paid by the LA State USBC. Entrants will be required to pay all of their expenses for the tournament.
10. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between 220 and the bowler's average.
11. All other USBC Rules not covered by the above will be in effect for this tournament.
